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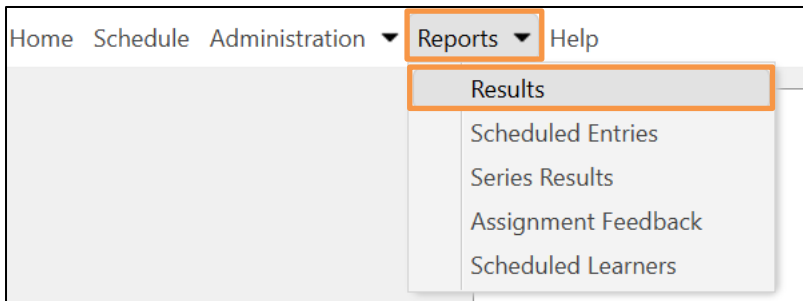
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1. How to access results

Online assessment administration is performed within our Linx2Achieve e-testing system. For a login link please go to the [About e-testing page](#).

1) From the Reports menu, select Results



2) When you first view the results page you will be presented with results for all exams sat within the last 6 months. To look back further use the 'Date from' picker.

You can also use the filter boxes to narrow your search. Simply type in what you want to look for; for example, typing in a learner's VTCT registration number into the Learner Number box and hitting enter will display results for just that learner, for the date range selected.

3) You can Print/Export the summary results page (as displayed on-screen).



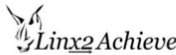
4) To view individual reports, select the check box to the left of the result(s) you want to print.
